Depending on the number of dogs entered for the championship the breeds can be moved to another day. The team leader of every country will be informed about rescheduling at the latest 7 days after the closing date.







Registration / Veterinary control:

15 minutes after the last final till 19:00, only for dogs competing on Sunday

Valid EU vaccination passport which must be presented at each veterinary control. Only rabies vaccination is mandatory, administered at least 21 days before

transferring into Germany. Validity of the rabies vaccination is equal to the expiry

date in the vaccination passport.

Identification: The dog must have a readable microchip or readable tattoo.

Control measurement: Whippets and Italian Sighthounds which are not registered in the CdL database

with a control measurement on an FCI title event will be control measured (FCI regulations §1.5.1 and §1.5.3). These control measurements will be supervised by

the FCI delegate of this event..

CdL Sprinter-Winner: For Italian Greyhound sprinters and Whippet sprinters. See §1.4.2. section 8. and 9.

for the height limits, and §4.6 Sprinter events titles.

Race distance: For cirneco dell'Etna, italian greyhound and whippet 350 meters

For all other breeds 480 meters. (§4.12.1)

Track and lure: endless rail, sandtrack with irrigation system, UU-endless oval with a radius of

43 m, slightly bends, elektric lure system

Timing: Video timing camera for all six dogs (Etherlynx2000+) and back-upsystem

Doping tests: Doping tests will be executed according to the FCI regulations.

Liability: According to FCI regulations §1.11

Admission: - Maximum 12 dogs per country, per breed and gender.

- If there are six dogs per gender and per breed at the start in the FCI

Championship, one title can be awarded to the male winner and another to the female winner. If fewer than six dogs of either gender participate, dogs and bitches must compete together and only one title will be awarded (FCI regulations § 4.11). - If a total of fewer than six dogs and bitches of any breed at the start, no title will be given. In spite of this the FCI delegate together with the Jury can decide to award the title if the circumstances so require. The prizes which have been

announced will be awarded (FCI regulations § 4.11).







- If there are less than four dogs at the start, this particular breed cannot participate in the FCI Championship (FCI regulations § 4.11).
- A disqualification between the entry closing date and the date of the championship precludes participation.

The qualifying period for competing dogs who have only 1 result in their license book at the entry deadline, is extended from the entry deadline (19.07.2021) until two weeks before the start of the event (18.08.2021).

Qualification for finals:

The dogs, which qualify for the finals, are selected based on the times they recorded in the preliminary heats.

Every dog, except for Greyhounds, must take part in a minimum of two preliminary heats, the final being the third race. The quicker of the times recorded in the two preliminary heats is the time, which will be used to qualify for the final.

For Greyhounds, only one preliminary heat is compulsory, a second one being optional.

The dogs with the six fastest times run in the final. (§4.16.1)

Entries for the championships can only be done by the national organization of each country. Entries can be sent only in the official excel file, which is sent in advance, attached with this invitation.

Entry fee 60.00 € per dog: The Payment of the entry fee by the national organizations must be made to the following account not later than 25.07.2021. If the EC2021 has to be cancelled due to the local COVID-19 situation, there is a non-refundable amount of the entry fee of € 25,00. Payment of entry fee by the team leader is not possible on site. CACIL allocation:

CACIL will be awarded according to the FCI regulations §5. When the National Organization on the registration form indicates that the dog is entitled to receive a CACIL, this is accepted as evidence.

Catalogue: The catalogue can be purchased at $7 \in$ upon registration of dogs.

Liability / Responsibility:

According to §1.11 FCI rules, neither the organizer nor the official are liable for accidents of dog owners, officials or dogs. This expands to lost dogs as well. The dog owner is not liable in case of an injury caused by his hound to another hound while racing. In any other case, the dog owner is responsible/liable for his dog before, during and after the race.

For an eventual cancellation of the event, beyond the organizer's responsibility, no liability will be taken.

Especially in the case of a cancellation based on a corona protection ordinance from the state of Germany, NRW or the district of Steinfurt. In this case, only 35€ per report will be reimbursed to the national organizations after the registration deadline on July 19, 2021. With the notification, the country organizations accept this procedure.
